At a meeting of the Amenities & Leisure Committee of Earley Town Council held on Wednesday, 26th October, Councillors were asked to consider the Annual Supervising Engineer's Report for Maiden Erlegh Lake. The report is required because the Lake is also a reservoir and has to be maintained to a certain standard.
