



At a meeting of the Policy & Resources Committee held on 25<sup>th</sup> January Earley Town Councillors considered the budget for the forthcoming financial year starting April 2012. The approved budget will now be considered by the full Council on 15<sup>th</sup> February at which time the Council Tax Precept for the next financial year will be agreed.

In considering this budget the Council will continue to support the Help Shop at the Council Offices in Radstock Lane which provides advice and services not only on behalf of the Town Council but also for Wokingham Borough Council.

At the Policy & Resources Committee meeting Councillors were informed by the Town Clerk that, as an additional new service, the Help Shop will be selling books of first and second class postage stamps.

Councillors were all agreed that another valuable addition had been made to the range of services offered by the Earley Help Shop.
