



Earley Town Council's representative at the Borough Council's forthcoming Planning Committee Meeting will be expressing concern about two separate Planning Applications that are being considered.

The first, which is the redevelopment of the Hatch Farm Dairies site, although in Winnersh, is of concern to the Town Council, as the proposal allows for the construction of a new link road which will join Lower Earley Way between the Sindlesham Mill and Loddon Bridge roundabouts. Not only will this road be built across the floodplain, which could increase the potential for flooding in the Lower Earley area, it will also increase the amount of traffic travelling along Lower Earley Way.

The second application is in relation to the demolition of the Sibly Hall building in Redhatch Drive, Earley and the construction of 99 dwellings. The Town Council has a number of concerns about this Outline application, not least of which is the detrimental impact it will have on the listed Ancient Woodland of Redhatch Copse and the potential to significantly increase the traffic in Redhatch Drive and surrounding areas.
