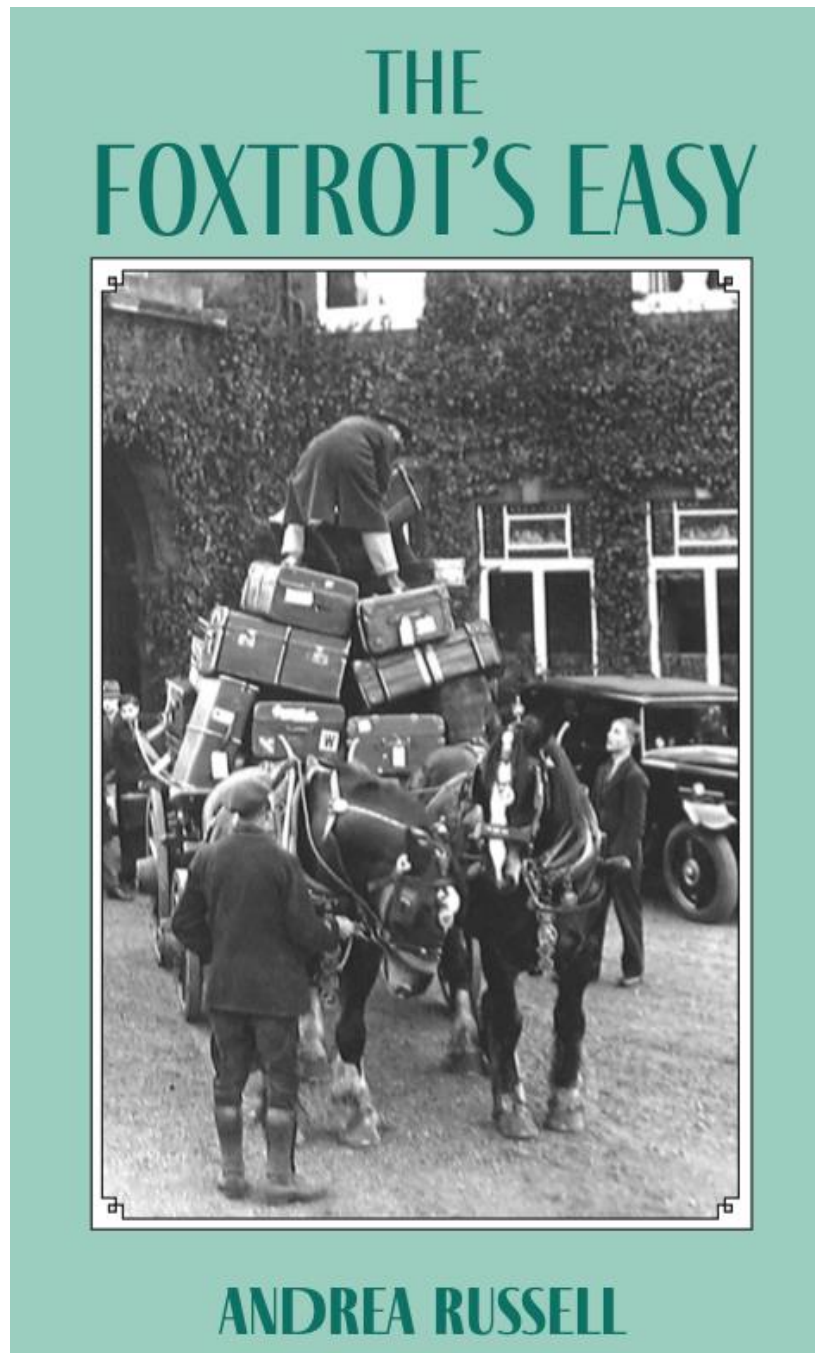


THE FOXTROT'S EASY - EARLEY'S FIRST NOVEL
