

Website Accessibility Statement

Earley Town Council is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with the Public Sector Bodies (Website & Mobile Applications) (No2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.

Compliance

The website is partially compliant with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 AA standard and improvements are ongoing. Recent improvements include: -

- Improvements to keyboard navigation and menu usability
- Ongoing work to improve document and PDF accessibility (if applicable)
- General usability and contrast/readability enhancements across key pages

Non-Accessible Content

Some pages contain content and attachments which are not currently compliant with accessibility regulations; they may include:

- Older PDFs and scanned documents are rarely fully accessible
- Some older images may be missing meaningful alternative text

The Town Council aims to identify non-compliant content and, where possible, work with its website provider to rectify this, as well as ensure any PDFs published to the website are accessible moving forward.

On the website, users will find an Accessibility Widget in the bottom right-hand corner, which allows users to adjust text size, change colour contrasts, change fonts, highlight links, pause animations, hide images (and more) to give greater accessibility.
